

- •By this point, Germany had already been pushing 440 domestically through the Reichsmusikkammer.
- •The U.S. had begun adopting 440 in orchestras and broadcasting.
- •The London conference gave these moves an international stamp of approval.
- •War, looming and then breaking out that same year, ensured dissent was drowned in larger chaos.

3. Why 440 Hz?

- •435 Hz (the French "diapason normal") was close to 432 Hz the natural coherence anchor
